JOB SUMMARY:

The incumbent works as part of the Food Service team in the provision of safe and nutritious meals for patients, residents, staff, customers and other users of the HRHSSA in a manner consistent with high standards of food preparation and nutrition. Meals are provided for the assigned site, which may include patients, residents, visitors, 5-10 "Meals on Wheels" clients and approximately 15-90 cafeteria patrons for lunch meals. Failure to perform duties completely, safely, and promptly would directly affect the service delivery of the department, and may affect the well-being and comfort of clients.

- Basic knowledge & skills related to nutrition, cooking, serving methods, and portion control.

- Must have ability to read, interpret and comprehend menus, procedures, recipes, etc. in English.
