Physiotherapy services are provided in accordance with legislation, standards, guidelines and ethics of the CCHSA, provincial licensing body, Canadian Physiotherapy Association and policies of the Hay River Health & Social Services Authority.

- Knowledge of current Physiotherapy theory and standards of practice.

- Ability to solve problems through flexibility, adaptability and creativity to work within available resources.
- Ability to communicate through verbal and written means to effectively provide physiotherapy services to a multidimensional patient population.
