A temporary recruitment and retention supplement will be offered to front line Registered Nurse, Nurse Practitioner, Midwifery, Occupational Therapist and Physiotherapist positions within the Hay River Health and Social Services Authority. The successful incumbent will receive a \$6000 supplement upon hire and an additional \$6000 supplement after completion of 12 months of continuous employment contingent on remaining employed in an eligible position for a further 12 months. This is a taxable benefit and will be subject to applicable deductions

The Registered Nurse - Acute & Ambulatory Care is a regulated member of the health care team who uses the nursing process (assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation), critical thinking, problem solving and decision making skills, in keeping with the standards, and scope of nursing practice set by the College and Association of Nurses of the Northwest Territories and Nunavut (CANN). The RN also adheres to the policies, protocols, and guidelines of the Hay River Health & Social Services Authority, to provide quality nursing care to all clients, families, groups, communities and populations across the lifespan in all practice settings.

The RN is a generalist who provides nursing care to clients with acute, emergency, surgical, postoperative recovery, maternity/newborn and palliative care needs.

Qualifications:

- Current registration with the College and Association of Nurses of the Northwest Territories and Nunavut or ability to attain such registration
- BSN degree is desirable
- Current CPR certification
- Current ACLS & PALS certification (or willingness to obtain within 6 months of hire)
- ENPC & TNCC certification is desirable
- Experience in an acute care hospital is required

This level of knowledge is commonly acquired through the successful completion of a Bachelor's Degree in Nursing or a Diploma in Nursing from an approved school of nursing. Nursing experience in a variety of clinical areas is desirable and experience in Medicine, Surgery and ER is preferred.

In addition to an attractive salary, we offer a Northern Allowance of \$2.42 per hour up to \$4,711 per year. All job offers are subject to references, a satisfactory Criminal Records Check (including vulnerable sector search) and an Employee Health Risk Assessment.
