Most of the assignments given to this position will occur outdoors however there may be indoor assignments due to inclement weather or other operational requirements.

- Able to work independently with minimal supervision
- Some experience with landscaping, horticulture or painting would be an asset.
- Must possess a valid Class 5 NWT Driver's License with a good driving abstract
